Leaving your pet with us for Surgery?

If your pet will be having surgery, here is what to expect:

We will use the morning hours to let your pet settle in, relax and adjust to a different environment. The Doctor & Technician will perform a pre-procedure evaluation.

The Doctor will also review any laboratory results and write the orders for any medications, treatments or procedures to be done.

IV catheters will be placed and IV fluids will be started

The technicians will administer medications that have been ordered by the Doctor.

Any Radiographs that have not already been taken will also be done.

Most procedures usually start late in the morning.

Patients are generally ready for discharge between 3:00 and 5:00 pm.

If Your pet was left for us to address a medical need:

Pets will be examined throughout the day as time permits. Please keep in mind that pets in pain, or whose conditions may worsen are given priority.

Want a status report?

A nurse or Doctor usually will contact you with a condition update or with a discharge time throughout the day. If you have not heard from us by 2:00 pm, please feel free to call us.
